- The **Beechworth Courthouse** is currently home to **The Kelly Trials Exhibition** which provides an immersive 270-degree, wrap-around multimedia experience, telling the stories of crime and punishment, governance and law, and bushranger Ned Kelly. After the digital presentation guests will have time to explore the remainder of the building with its original furniture and fixtures as well as the incredible new exhibits on display.
- The **Burke Museum** is one of the oldest in Australia and is proudly known as "the museum of museums". It boasts a collection of over 30,000 items, many dating back over 150 years.
- The **Beechworth Guided Gold Rush Walking Tour** tells the story of the 1850s Gold Rush in Beechworth - once the richest alluvial goldfields in Victoria. Participants will learn the stories behind significant historic buildings, people and events that helped shape Beechworth, visiting many of the buildings associated with governance on the goldfields.
